Principals Report

Ms. DiRoma wished everyone a Happy New Year. She reminded everyone about the 3 day weekend in observance of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day and announced the Kindergarten Open House to be held on Thursday January 11, 2024 at 8:30am in the ECC building.

SLT Report

Alexios Mantzarlis gave a report of the recent School Leadership Team Meeting. Teachers will be sending out promotion in doubt letters to students setting expectations on whether they are on track for promotion / graduation. These letters don't mean students are being held back, but provide an opportunity to warn that an acceleration in progress is needed.

Computer-based testing (CBT) will be rolled out this year for standardized tests to grade 5 students (science, math, ELA) and grade 8 students (science, math, ELA). Some other schools will have CBT for all grades this year, PSIS78 is starting with the mandated ones. Next year all grades 3-8 will move to CBT. One round of practice tests has been completed and another one will be conducted between Jan 16 and 26 to test student, staff and system readiness.

DOE has recently updated the WiFi in school and will be gradually testing it to avoid overwhelming the NextTerra testing system.

PSIS78 put in a capital project request to upgrade security cameras and for auditorium upgrades. Projects are reviewed by CEC and the DOE then determines spending based on priorities and needs.
